Dear Parent/Carer,

I am delighted to inform you that we have an Easter School Revision offer to support your child in the lead up to their final exams. This will take place at the academy, with the support of their expert and dedicated teachers and our Raising Achievement team, who have all given up their time for the benefit of the students.

What time should my child arrive for Easter School?

Children should arrive by 9:45am, where they will be offered breakfast. The first sessions will then begin promptly at 10am.

What happens if my child is only coming to the afternoon session?

We will have some facilities/snacks for lunch on site, so students can arrive for 12noon if they'd like to access this. Alternatively, they must arrive just before 12:30pm when the session begins promptly.

Where should my child go when they arrive?

When students arrive, they should access the academy via the 'late gate'/attendance door located at the front of the main school building. From here, students must ensure they are registered, for both safety and Prom Point reasons. They will congregate in the Entrance Hall for breakfast/lunch before going to their guided session.



What should my child wear for Easter School?

Whilst we do not expect students to come in their school uniform, they must come in appropriate, comfortable clothing. This means no cropped tops, ripped jeans, offensive slogans or pyjamas. They must ensure that they come equipped and ready to learn with the stationery that they require for revision sessions, such as a pen and their knowledge organiser.

What if my child is not invited in for the invite only sessions?

If your child has not been invited for the Maths sessions, there will still be resources and staff onsite to support them with targeted revision to help them to succeed, such as Sparx independent learning. They should still come into the academy to access this support.

Will my child be awarded prom points for attendance?

Absolutely! We'd like to recognise the hard work of our Year 11 students and would like to reward them with points for prom for their attendance to Easter School. Ten prom points will be awarded for every session that they attend. A bonus ten prom points will be awarded if they attend all possible sessions during the week.

I would like to remind you that usual expectations around behaviour will apply when the students are on site with us. This means that mobile phones should be off and away when on site, and they should ensure that they are participating in the sessions being provided for them. We reserve the right to ask students to leave if they do not meet our expectations.

We are really excited about this opportunity, and hope that the students will find it helpful as they prepare for some of the most important weeks of their lives.
