What a fantastic week it has been in the academy this week. Discretionary Grants from the Household Support Fund - Suffolk County Council (SCC) is pleased to confirm that the Government announced a six-month extension to the Household Support Fund from September 2024 to March 2025. The grant will be issued as a £30 supermarket voucher for each eligible child from Pluxee and is designed to help families with their essential living costs during the holiday. Please note these vouchers will have a 2-month expiry, after which vouchers cannot be reissued. A more detailed letter on how to claim these vouchers will be issued to parents soon.

We are hosting 'An Evening of Poetry and Music' on Thursday 12th December starting from 6pm. This evening will see a host of students showing off their own poetry and music skills. Parents of those performing will be invited separately, but this is an event we wish to open to all parents.
