## **Year 10 GCSE Information Summary**

On Thursday 18th September 2025, Ormiston Denes Academy hosted the *Welcome to GCSE Evening* for Year 10 students. It was fantastic to see so many families in attendance. For those unable to join, this letter outlines the key messages shared.

#### Why Year 10 Matters

Year 10 marks the beginning of the GCSE journey. All work completed from now contributes to final grades. Some subjects, such as BTECs, include assessments e.g. Pearson Set Assignment (PSA's) that must be completed in school under exam conditions. Attendance is essential, as every grade contributes to a points score used for college applications.

## **Keys to Success**

#### Attendance

Students with 95%+ attendance consistently achieve better outcomes due to access to expert teaching and pastoral support. Even when slightly unwell, students should attend where possible support is always available.

#### Home Learning

Students use two online platforms:

- Sparx (Maths) due Wednesdays
- Tassomai (English, Science, History, Geography, MFL) due Sundays
   Deadlines are in student planners. Higher completion rates have been linked to better grades.
   Students should take responsibility for tracking and completing tasks.

## Study Hall

Year 10 students are encouraged to attend Study Hall voluntarily. It runs daily from 3:10–4:10pm and offers a quiet study space with refreshments. Building good habits early is key.

### • Revision Techniques

Effective revision should begin early. Recommended strategies include:

Mind dumps, quizzing, dual coding, flashcards, and spaced practice – known as the Denes Desirables.

### Work Experience

Scheduled for 29th June—3rd July 2026. The process is managed via *Unifrog*. Students who attended the RAC evening received a guide booklet. If not yet received, please contact the academy. Placements should be secured by December due to high demand.
