

Dear Parent and Carers, 28th November 2025

It was fantastic to see so many of you attending the Christmas Fayre last night and to see so many students supporting the academy. We were incredibly proud of the great community spirit on display. Thank you to everyone who organised and supported the event and of course to the stall holders who took part.

Year 7 and Year 8 students were involved this week with an iWill Hack Assembly "unleashing public health benefits through social action". The event looked at young people's views in several areas, including communities, mental health and health, and environment. All students worked really hard and were all a credit to their schools. They shared their ideas on suggestions for improvements, and each group presented the work to their peers. Their work will be put into a report to link into the Suffolk Youth Strategy.

An **important letter will be sent shortly** informing you about our migrating to a new central information management system called **Arbor**. This change will reduce the number of parent portals you need to use to support your child at the academy and will streamline how we manage information at the academy. This letter contains important information for parents about this process. We will continue to provide both updates and guidance on this process, so we are ready for our school return after the Christmas holidays and our start with Arbor in January 2026.
