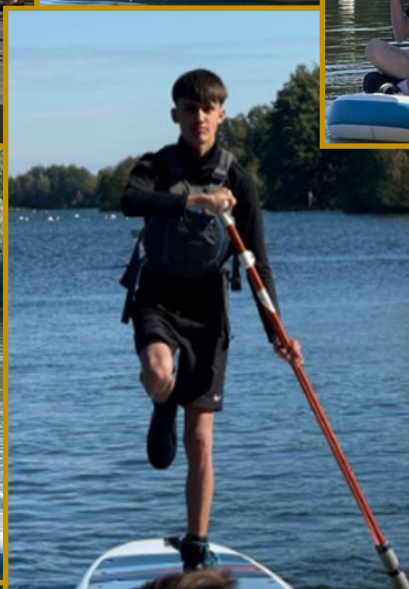

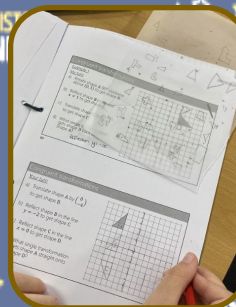

**Year 9** confidently showing off their whiteboard skills in History — active learning at its best!



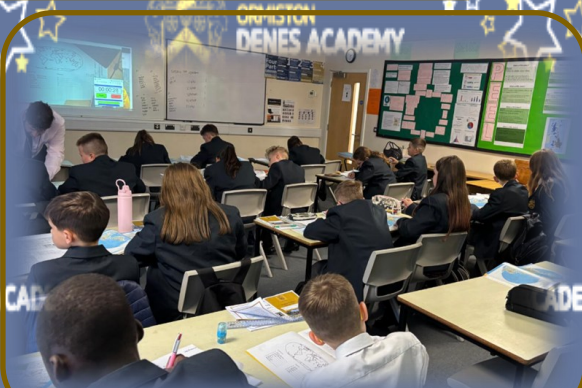

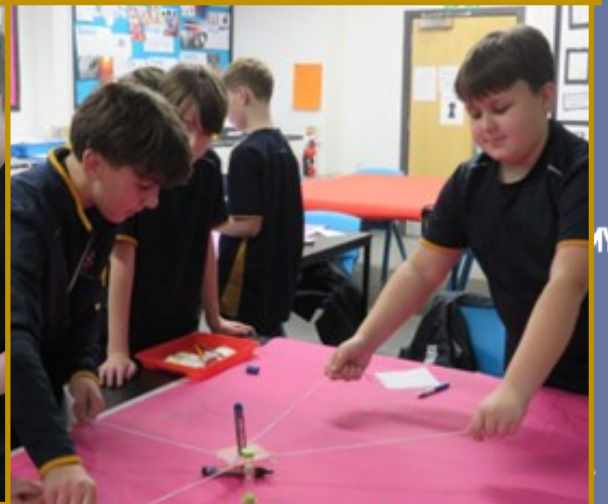
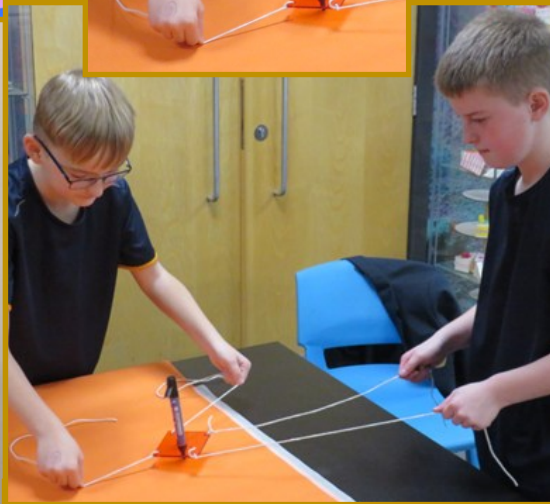
We are also very proud to confirm that our staff and students raised an incredible £334.98 in this year's non uniform day, supporting Children In Need.

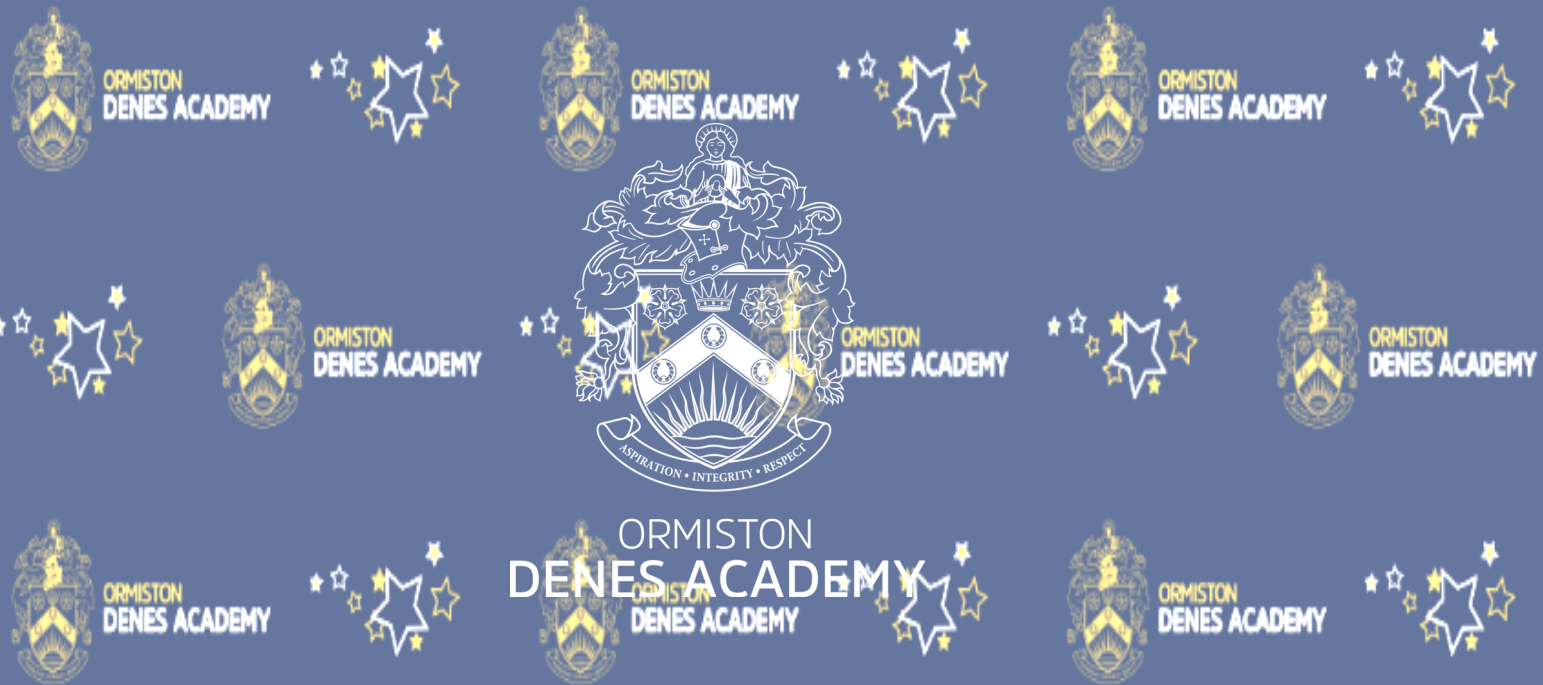
### Staff Farewells.
